Ranson Building at Emmanuel College required a modern refurbishment befitting of such a forward-thinking institution. The result was three unique and thoughtfully designed learning spaces enhanced by flooring from the attractive Palettone PUR collection.

- Orange Room: Foundation (8622) & Harvest Air (8620)
- Blue Room: Sapphire Star (8649) & Superior Sky (8648)
- Green Room: Garden Sage (8643) & Urban Air (8605)

The subtle, consistent pattern of Palettone PUR added visual interest. Furthermore, large, curved radius cut-outs (alongside a two-tone colour effect) enhanced the dynamic flow whilst balancing the overall design concept.

On-site, the flooring installation ran smoothly, with its design features adding welcome flair.
